The Challenge

As part of a corporate relocation from Brooklyn to Queens, Executive Charge needed to move its entire IT infrastructure quickly and affordably, without disrupting daily business operations.



The CloudFirst Solution

CloudFirst migrated 11 VMware production virtual machines, including MS Exchange, domain controllers, IIS web servers, and Oracle databases, to its Managed Cloud Hosting environment. The transition also included converting physical servers to VMware virtual machines, migrating internet-facing services, and moving the Barracuda Spam Filter Appliance to a cloud-hosted version. CloudFirst managed all associated networking changes, ensuring seamless access across all company locations.

The Results

In just three nights, CloudFirst successfully migrated Executive Charge's systems, services, DNS records, and mail settings to their new environment. The move reduced reliance on physical hardware at the new location, saving staff from the burden of hardware maintenance and repairs.
